

APPLICATION FOR PERFORMANCE HONORS

Performance Honors is an upper division program for students in the B.A. music, B.M. composition, B.M. music education, and B.M. music industry programs that wish to meet performance requirements at or near those required of performance majors. If recommended to the program, students will be able to receive 1 credit/hour lessons in place of their <u>required</u> 1 credit/half-hour lessons during their junior and senior years, at no extra cost(*). Students accepted into the Performance Honors program must give both a junior and senior recital commensurate with the requirements for degree recitals in the performance major.

The audition for the Performance Honors program will normally take place during the spring semester jury at the end of the sophomore year. The student will bring the Application for Performance Honors to that jury for signatures of approval. If the student is declined Performance Honors, the Area Coordinator may petition the Chair of the Department of Applied Music and Performance for a re-audition. Sophomores who plan to spend the spring semester abroad will audition during the Fall semester jury. If denied Performance Honors, that student may elect, with the approval and petition of the area coordinator, to re-audition at the beginning of the next fall semester.

Any student withdrawing from the Performance Honors program will owe CVPA the applied music fees for the extra half-hour of lessons during the semesters in which he/she was a Performance Honors student.

If you wish to be considered for Performance Honors, complete this form and present it to the jury panel prior to your jury performance. Your private instructor will inform you of the jury's decision.
